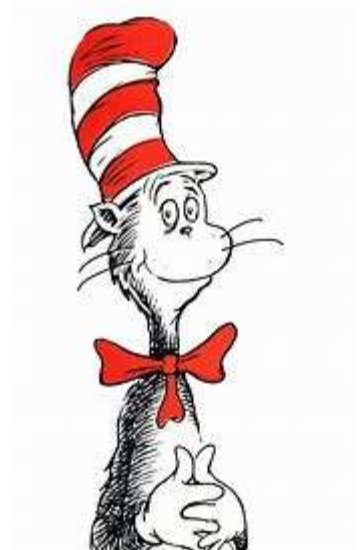
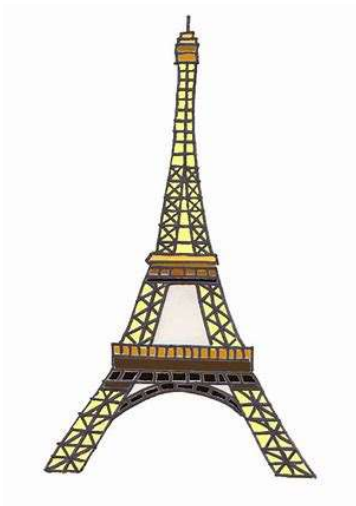

Parent Information

BOOKING INFORMATION:

Please book the required vacation care sessions through the XPLOR app. This vacation care, this will be our method for bookings. If you have yet to create an account with XPLOR, please do so through the welcome email that has been sent to the email address you have registered with us. If you have any issues with this, please get in touch and we will be happy to help.

Booked days are charged weekly in advance. A minimum of 24 hours required to cancel bookings otherwise full fee charged. Nonattendance on booked days will result in regular daily fee being charged. Additional days only available if sufficient places.

All bookings must be enrolled through XPLOR. The service cannot accept children until this enrolment process has been completed. Please get in touch via email for the enrolment link if required.

Closed in shoes are recommended and are required to be worn when on excursions. As children are able to go bare foot inside, a pair of thongs can be sent for wearing to bathroom (no bare feet in toilets).

Excursions. Due to staffing levels on these days, numbers may be capped. If you are unable to secure a place, you can be placed on a waiting list. Short day sessions are not available on excursion days.

Daily Requirements. Children are required to bring: a **hat, a water bottle and ALL food / snacks** each day. Please do not send food that requires heating or cooking as we are unable to do this. Cold items are unable to be stored in a fridge. Please clearly label ALL personal items.

The service supplies sunscreen and insect spray but if your child requires a specific type, please send it with your child.

Toys, phones or electronic games NOT ALLOWED.
